
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## **Materials Supplied**

- -Five colors of cardstock: gray, white, lighter tone, darker tone, and metallic
- -Glue stick (optional)

#### **Materials Needed**

- -Pencil
- -Scissors
- -Picture frame (4x6)



#### **Trim**

With this Take & Make kit, cardstock has been trimmed down to fit 4 x 6 picture frame.

## **Make Geode Layers**

- 1. Arrange cardstock colors. Gray would be on top. Vary the colors as desired.
- 2. Starting with gray cardstock draw a large wavy half circle with points starting and ending at the same long side of cardstock.
- 3. Cut along drawn line.
- 4. Line up white cardstock underneath gray cardstock and make a slightly smaller semicircle, roughly following the wavy shape on the gray cardstock.
- 5. Cut along drawn line.
- 6. Continue process cutting smaller and smaller shapes with each layer, varying the light tone, dark tone, metallic, and white.
- 7. The final bottom layer should not be cut.

## Glue (Optional)

8. Use glue stick to adhere the layers in order of largest cut to no cut.

## Frame and Enjoy

9. Place into frame and display.







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
